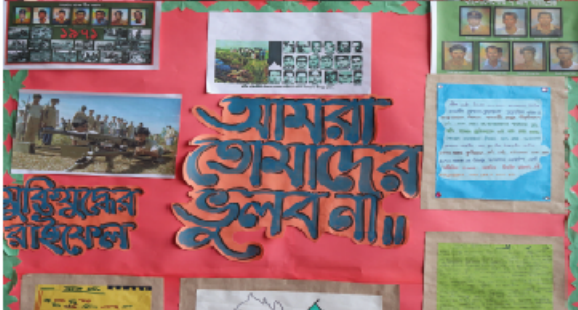
## Visit to the Post Office

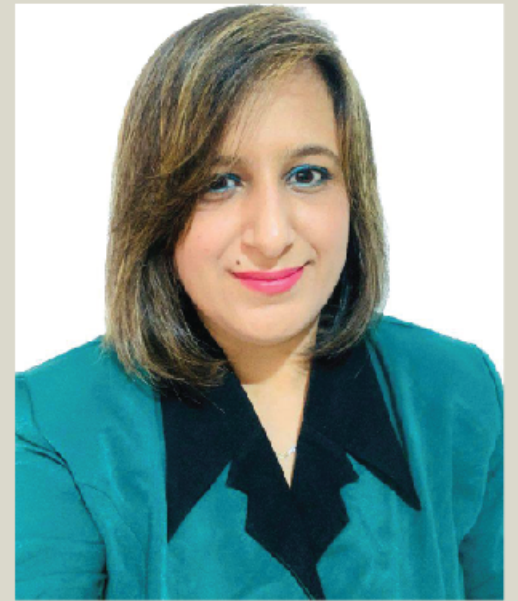
## French Certificate
