

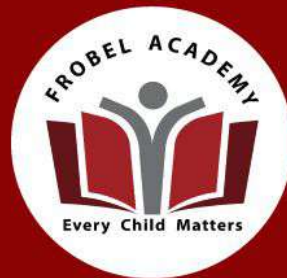

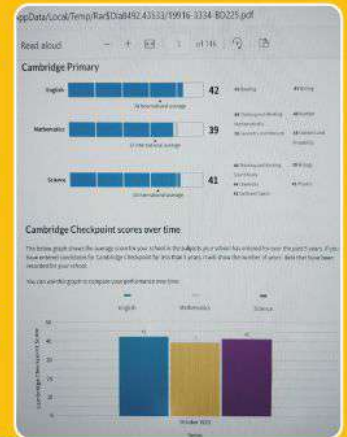
Cambridge Primary Checkpoint Examination-October, 2023

With such extensive training we believe that our teachers are now ready to adopt a more student-centered approach and create engaging learning environments that will empower every child to reach their full potential.

Design for Change



As always Frobel Academy aims to use experiential, joyful learning to create a community of global leaders. Frobel aims to build citizenship and leadership in our learners from an early age. Design for Change (DFC) is one of our learning processes which helps bring out the leadership of our learners for the betterment of the society. The process is designed to emotionally prepare students for uncertainty and complexity in their future lives by helping them recognise their

strengths and bring change. Our learners take challenges to find out problems from their surroundings and solve those as they consider themselves as accountable citizens.

This year our Grade 2 learners have identified problems in our canteen/play area and also working on noise management in the classroom from excessive furniture movement. Our Grade 3 learners are working on waste management to recycle and make compost fertilizer using food wastages. Grade 4 learners are focusing on recycling used school uniforms to make different useful products and installing road markers (coloring electric poles and speed breakers) on our school road in order to prevent road accidents. Grade 5 learners are creating awareness in our neighborhood- not to throw garbage everywhere and also using collaborative space at level 2 for some exciting games/ interactive sessions. Our Grade 6 learners are re-designing and renovating the living room at Old Age Home. Grade 7 learners are installing a sensory board at Shishu Paribar and lastly our Grade 8 learners are installing a water dispenser outside the school gate for the pedestrians and drivers.
